



5.0 Player Identification

- 5.1 In all cases in which a player or coach is playing or coaching for a team, the player must possess an "Ontario Soccer Registrant Book" or "ONTARIO SOCCER Identification Card" and have such document available for presentation at the game in which he/she is playing/coaching upon request. Failure to present the "Ontario Soccer Registrant Book" or "Ontario Soccer Identification Card" shall render the player/coach ineligible to play/coach in that game.
- 5.2 Authorized Identification Cards / Player Book Inspection Procedure:
- a) All players form two individual lines by team
 - b) Each player holds their own identification card / player book with the photo showing.
 - c) A team official from the opposing team, with a copy of the opposing teams game sheet, inspect each identification card / book to the player:
 - d) Match the photograph to the player
 - e) Match validated current season / year information
 - f) Check back for discipline
 - g) A team official from the opposing team, with a copy of the opposing teams game sheet, inspects each team officials book:
 - h) Match photograph to the team official
 - i) Match validated current season/year information
 - j) Check back for discipline
